

Sandy Bay Rowing Club Membership definitions

Membership Categories

Voting rights are bestowed to “Ordinary Members” and “Life Members” as per the constitution.

The committee has agreed to the following additions to the definition of an Ordinary Member:

1. A rower who is over the age of 18 at the time of application, has paid the full membership fee as of 1 January and been approved by the committee.

Or

2. A coach, coxswain or student member who is over 18 years of age, applied for full membership before 1 January, paid the relevant membership fee as agreed by committee at time of application and been approved by the committee

Coach

Coaches pay a reduced fee as per the schedule, but do not have voting rights unless they upgrade to become an Ordinary Member as per above.

Coxswains

Coxswains pay a reduced fee as per the schedule, but do not have voting rights unless they upgrade to become an Ordinary Member as per above.

Fahan rowers and coaches

Fahan rowers and coaches are categorised as associate members of the club. They have rights to the club and equipment as per the MOU, but do not have voting rights at the AGM.
